Winter Wonderland Party / Disco – proposed to hold this at the end of term split into Junior classes infants from 1.30pm to 2.30 1st & 2nd from 2.30 to 4.00 and 3rd to 6th from 5pm to 7pm with an appearance from Santa for the junior classes. All kids would receive a selection box at home time. Family Bingo Night – proposed for late Feb early Mar AGM – following a well attended AGM we have gained 3 new committee members and 1 former member. Ideally we would like to have a teacher rep on the committee thus becoming a Parent Teacher Committee. We raised €6000 for 2018/19 plus book credit of €3362. As agreed this money is to be used to purchase outdoor play equipment for the new school. Our first meeting for the 2019/20 school year is Tues 1st October where we will elect/reelect the roles and also discuss what the funds raised this year are to be put towards.
