4. Jupiter is -145 degrees Celsius! [That is very cold]

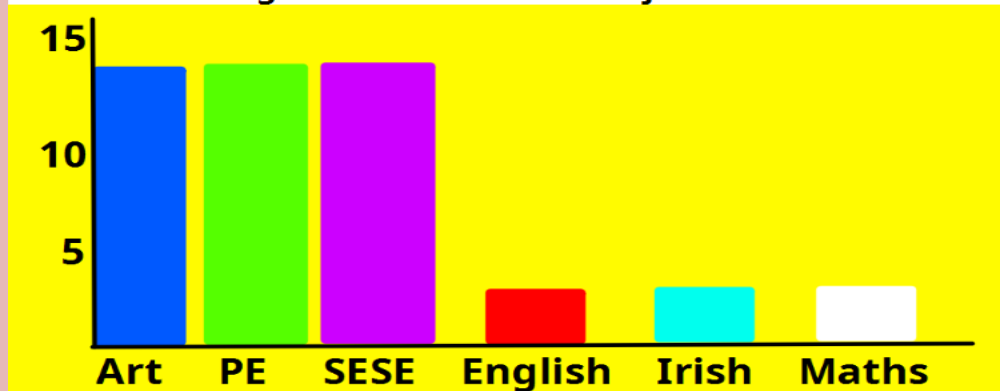
I asked them "If you could travel back in time where would you go and what would you do?" They would want to go to space and be the first people to land on the moon. They also said that they would visit the dinosaurs.
