Our School Community and Ethos	The focus of School Self Evaluation this year will be Maths (Problem Solving). We will begin a period of data collection.
Teaching and Learning	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• We held our Winter performances. This year, we held them for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> classes and the remaining classes will do a variety concert in the Spring time.</li> <li>• The whole school have been making their way through the Weaving Wellbeing programme as part of SPHE. This term the focus will be on Stay Safe (<b>As per the Boards obligation to implement</b>)</li> <li>• 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> class have been doing foreign languages (Spanish and French).</li> <li>• This term we will begin work on vegetable growing in the classrooms with a view to planting out in April.</li> <li>• 3<sup>rd</sup> class and 4<sup>th</sup> class have been trialling using levelled readers in Gaeilge. The children work in groups with a book at their level. 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> class have been trialling an Irish phonics programme.</li> <li>• Staff have been updating their long term plans and developing new Long Term plans in line with the new Primary Maths Curriculum.</li> <li>• Staff are continuing to engage with the 4 new curriculum specifications. We have established curriculum committees who will meet to examine the new curriculum areas and to begin to map our current good practice onto the areas and also identify the priority future learning for our pupils.</li> <li>• Maths: This term, we will be encouraging teachers to engage with micro maths in the classroom and a problem solving box.</li> <li>• This term we have Kickboxing lessons happening for 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> class as part of the PE curriculum.</li> </ul>

Other notes	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The providers of after school clubs started up again. There are a number of clubs such as drama, kick boxing, public speaking tennis, art, keyboard, science and chess due to recommence in the new year.</li> <li>• The school quiz teams are up and running again. There will be a number of school competitions in January.</li> <li>• Children engaged in bulb planting around the school</li> <li>• Music workshops were held in December for 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> class with Paul Maher. There was also a puppet show for infants to 3<sup>rd</sup> class and our autism classes.</li> <li>• A class of children visited TLC to sing for them in December. They was also visit from the choir in Scoil Aoife.</li> <li>• The choir will be performing as part of the Peace Proms in February in the RDS. There was a rehearsal in late December. The choir will also travel to the Big Sing in March.</li> <li>• A student in 4<sup>th</sup> class has won the regional Credit Union competition and will now go onto the National Final.</li> <li>• The school had a visit from the Green School rep to assess the school's implementation of the green flag programme.</li> </ul>
